EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- 1. The Commissioner has approved the budget for 2014 15 (Decision 2013/41) which includes an allocation of £1.794M for Community Safety and Partnership Funding.
- 2. In line with the approach agreed by the Commissioner the Partnerships Officer has held discussions with a number of partners regarding the continuation of funding or the recommissioning of specific services and programmes which support the Commissioner's aims and priorities.
- 3. This Decision seeks to confirm the allocation of £860,000, representing 48% of the budget, to the partners, projects or initiatives detailed in the attached Appendix.
- 4. If this Decision is confirmed, there will be a balance of £934,000 remaining in the Community Safety & Partnership Fund for allocation against additional community safety activity.
