## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

This report provides an overview of, and seeks the approval of the Police and Crime Commissioner to the revised Scheme of Consent/Delegation and Code of Corporate Governance following the disestablishment of the role of Deputy Police and Crime Commissioner.

## RECOMMENDATION

The Police and Crime Commissioner is recommended to approve the revised Scheme of Consent/Delegation and Code of Corporate Governance.

## 1. Information

- 1.1 In order to enhance the efficiency and functionality of the office the Police and Crime Commissioner ("the Commissioner"), on the 19 November 2014 approved a new interim structure to run until the 31 May 2015.
- 1.2 This decision (2014/40) saw the disestablishment of 4 posts, namely the Deputy Police and Crime Commissioner and the 3 Assistant Police & and Crime Commissioners.
- 1.3 The Deputy Police and Crime Commissioner was appointed under the provisions of the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011 in December 2012 following a Confirmation Hearing by the Police and Crime Panel for Lancashire and undertook a number of delegated functions on behalf of the Commissioner as set out in the Scheme of Consent/Delegation.

- 1.4 The Commissioner is not required by law to appoint a Deputy Police and Crime Commissioner, and in disestablishing the post, the Commissioner recognised the need to review the Scheme of Governance.
- 1.5 A review of the Scheme of Governance has now been undertaken and a revised Scheme of Consent/Delegation and Code of Corporate Governance are attached for approval. The Chief Constable has been consulted and agrees to the revised amendments.
