<b>Summary:</b>	DENW will run group discussions with disabled people on personal safety, supporting them to identify where they, their home or their belongings may be at risk and identify solutions on how they can protect themselves and decrease potential risks.		
<b>Comments:</b>	DENW work in partnership with Preston City Council and Lancashire Constabulary to address 'hot-spots' and areas of concern.

<b>Summary:</b>	The Friends of Cavendish Road Recreation Ground will run a range of diversionary activities to young people over the summer holiday period.		
<b>Comments:</b>	The grounds have been targeted to anti-social behaviour and the group aim to reduce the amount of ASB through positive engagement with the youngsters.

That a grant of <b>£1,400</b> is provided to the Friends of Cavendish Road Recreation Ground <b>conditional</b> they work with the local policing team and confirm how they will target young people.</li> </ol>

<b>Summary:</b>	Over a 12 month period Layton Community House (LCH) will run sessions for the local community on safety concerns as well as advice and information on pressing issues such as domestic abuse, child sexual exploitation, debt advice etc.		
<b>Comments:</b>	Layton Community House also provide a variety of group activities such as craft groups as well as holding bereavement and mental health recovery group support sessions.		
<b>Recommendation:</b>	1. That this application is supported by the Commissioner. 2. That a grant of £1,175 is offered to Layton Community House to part fund the initiative.

<b>AREA:</b>	West Lancashire	<b>PRIORITY:</b>	Supporting vulnerable people and victims
<b>AMOUNT REQUESTED:</b>	£2,430	<b>Match Funds:</b>	£700 – Clocktower Rotary & organisations own resources
<b>Project Name &amp; Cost</b>	Skem International £3,530		
<b>Summary:</b>	Skelmersdale Outreach Trust works with asylum seekers and refugees. The Skem international project will provide weekly games sessions over a six month period.		
<b>Comments:</b>	At the sessions asylum seekers and refugees will be able to access support, advice and information from local groups. The local PCSO's regularly attend the sessions to provide reassurance to asylum seekers and refugees, in particularly in relation to hate crime incidents.		
<b>Recommendation:</b>	1. That this application is supported by the Commissioner. 2. That a grant of £2,430 is provided to the Skelmersdale Outreach Trust.

<b>Project Name &amp; Cost</b>	Cue Youth Engagement £5,100		
<b>Summary:</b>	The Cue Foundation would like to take a group of young people to take part in various workshops organised by the Parliamentary Education Services where young people will take part in a series of 'Laws and Debating' workshops.		
<b>Comments:</b>	Upon their return, the young people will organise a project / workshops to raise awareness of crime in their local community and then work with other young people, the community, local organisations as well as the Constabulary to help tackle the issues raised.		
<b>Recommendation:</b>	1. That this application is supported by the Commissioner. 2. That a grant of £1,800 is offered to the Cue Foundation to part fund the initiative.

<b>Details:</b>	Blackburn Youth Zone would like funding for the transport of young people, 3 times per week to and from the youth zone where young people can take part in a range of activities.		
<b>Recommendation:</b>	1. That this application is <b>NOT</b> supported by the Commissioner. 2. That it is noted that Blackburn Youth Zone have more than £10,000 in unrestricted reserves and are therefore ineligible for CAF funding.

<b>Details:</b>	The Friends of Kirkham Park will run a one day, open air live music event which will be organised by a team of young volunteers with HMP Kirkham supporting the set up period. The aim of the event is to encourage creative thinking, aspiration and enthusiasm within the community.		
<b>Recommendation:</b>	1. That this application is <b>NOT</b> supported by the Commissioner. 2. That it is noted that the project does not fully support the Commissioner's priorities.

<b>Details:</b>	LGBT Out in the Bay are running a Pride event to celebrate lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender and intersex culture. LGBT Out in the Bay would like funding to support the event which includes a parade and street fair.		
<b>Recommendation:</b>	1. That this application is <b>NOT</b> supported by the Commissioner. 2. That it is noted that the Commissioner has already committed £1,000 to the Lancaster Pride 18 event and therefore LGBT Out in the Bay are ineligible for CAF funding.
