Executive Summary

This report seeks the approval of the Police and Crime Commissioner to award a contract to Burnley, Pendle and Rossendale Council for Voluntary Service for the provision of DBS checks to community organisations in Lancashire.

- 1.1. In conjunction with the Our Lancashire service the Commissioner has agreed to create a scheme that will provide DBS checks to members of organisations that join the Our Lancashire website.
- 1.2. The Our Lancashire team will provide vouchers to community groups that sign up to the Our Lancashire website to be redeemed for a DBS check and an invitation to quote to provide these checks was advertised on the PCC website.
- 1.3. Only one organisation has submitted a bid to provide this service, Burnley, Pendle and Rossendale Council for Voluntary Service, and the Commissioner is recommended to award the contract to this organisation.
