Project Name & Cost	£820 Wuds 4 Fun		
Summary:	Corporation Park Bowling Association wish to hold an open day at their Park and invite young people and the local community to visit and learn about the outdoor activity. As well as the open day, the association will invite youngsters to take part in 8 taster sessions, one per week to encourage young people to take up the activity.		
Comments:	Corporation Park Bowling Association wish to target schools in order to reach young people at the risk of committing crime/ASB.		
Recommendation:	1. That this application is supported by the Commissioner 2. That a grant of £820 is provided to Corporation Park Bowling Association for the open day and bowling sessions.		

2. NAME:	Fishwick Rangers Youth Development Scheme

Summary:	Fishwick Rangers wish to provide a holiday scheme during the Easter period for 40 targeted youths. Young people will take part in a range of exciting activities, for example ice skating and go-karting.		
Comments:	Fishwick Rangers works with the youngsters who are from the wards of Fishwick and St. Mathews in Preston through structured sessions on a weekly basis. The aim of the scheme is to provide vulnerable youngsters at the risk of committing crime with enjoyment and satisfaction through diversionary activities.		
Recommendation:	1. That this application is supported by the Commissioner 2. That a grant of £1,500 is provided to towards cost of the project.		

3. NAME:	Westview Football Team

Summary:	Westview Football Team wish to support the development of a resident's football team to play in the local league. The team will mostly be made up of young, unemployed males. They also wish to develop a junior mixed team for local youths, which will involve weekly training sessions.		
Comments:	The group have developed a three year plan, which involves the adult team being self-financing by year 2 and the junior team in year 3.		
Recommendation:	1. That this application is supported by the Commissioner 2. That a grant of £2,500 is provided to Westview Football Team towards the start-up and development of the Football teams.

Comments:	Greater Preston Sports group have liaised with the local community support officers and constables as well as the Preston Community Safety Partnership to target areas where 'risk taking behaviour' is increasing.		
Recommendation:	1. That this application is supported by the Commissioner 2. That a grant of £2,400 is provided to towards the Greater Preston Sports Project.
