EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

1. The Commissioner has received notification from the Home Office of the allocation of Community Safety Fund for 2013-14 at £1.794M
2. The Commissioner confirmed in November 2012 that he would provide community safety funding for the three top tier authority areas as the same ratio as in 2012-13.
3. Following receipt of the funding notification from the Home Office this enabled the Commissioner to offer community safety funding at 100% of the 2012-13 level and to maintain the former Drugs Intervention Programme funding also at the 2012-13 level.
4. The Lancashire Youth Offending Partnership have proposed the joint commissioning of a Youth Triage Service as an effective and efficient approach to delivering a key project that supports the Commissioner's Aims and Priorities.
5. The Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner have undertaken detailed discussions with partners regarding the use of funding to support the Commissioner's Strategic Aims and Community Safety key Priorities resulting in the proposals outlined in Appendix A.

RECOMMENDATION

The Commissioner is recommended to approve the proposed use of the Community Safety Fund as outlined in Appendix A and to note the implications in respect of funding that could be available for additional community safety activity.
