BACKGROUND, ADVICE and CONSULTATION

The Victims and Witnesses Strategy has been developed following a comprehensive review of Victims Services in the pan-Lancashire area undertaken during 2013. The review and draft strategy were presented at a Working with Victims Consultation event in January 2014 and outcomes from the event included in the final version of the Strategy.

The Constabulary have also been consulted on the Strategy and responses from them incorporated into the final attached version of the document.

FINANCIAL COMMENTS

The financial implications of delivering the strategy will be covered by funding provided by the Ministry of Justice (MoJ) in relation to services for victims and witnesses. Additional funding for delivery of services that fall outside of the criteria set by the MoJ will need to be funded from Commissioner funding or alternative external funding sought.

EQUALITY COMMENTS

The ten key outcomes in the Strategy will apply to all victims and witnesses irrespective of any protected characteristics that may apply.

The Commissioner will ensure that any services commissioned for victims and witnesses and work with criminal justice partners to provide a more coordinated process will comply with all current equality legislation and monitoring of this will be included in any performance monitoring framework set up by the Commissioner.
