<b>AREA:</b>	Lancaster	<b>PRIORITY:</b>	Tackle Crime & ASB.
<b>AMOUNT REQUESTED:</b>	£1,000	<b>Match Funds:</b>	Organisations own resources.
<b>Project Name &amp; Cost</b>	Lancaster Community Alcohol Partnership £2,000		
<b>Summary:</b>	Emues UK work in partnership with the Police, Council, Schools and many other partners to deliver the CAP (Community Alcohol Partnership) project in Lancaster. As part of the project, Emues would like to deliver self-defence lessons as a diversionary activity to the young people.		
<b>Comments:</b>	As part of the wider project, young people will take part in informal youth sessions to increase awareness of the risks associated with drinking Alcohol.		
<b>Recommendation:</b>	1. That this application is supported by the Commissioner. 2. That a grant of £1,000 is provided to Emues UK.

<b>Summary:</b>	Louie Horrocks Park with to purchase and install a fence with the aim to secure the area and reduce anti-social behaviour. The park has seen numerous ASB incidents and is repeatedly vandalised.		
<b>Recommendation:</b>	1. That this application is supported by the Commissioner 2. That a grant of £2,500 is provided to Friends of Louie Horrocks Park.

<b>AREA:</b>	Fylde	<b>PRIORITY:</b>	Tackle Re-offending & Protect Vulnerable People.
<b>AMOUNT REQUESTED:</b>	£2,500	<b>Match Funds:</b>	Fylde Council Community Projects Fund.
<b>Project Name &amp; Cost</b>	Integration through Sport £3,000		
<b>Summary:</b>	Fylde Walking Football Group work with vulnerable adults who have recently been released from custody with the aim to reintegrate and rehabilitate through weekly sport sessions.		
<b>Comments:</b>	Both the Police and the CRC (Community Rehabilitation Company) refer into the sessions.		
<b>Recommendation:</b>	1. That this application is supported by the Commissioner 2. That a grant of £2,500 is provided to Fylde Walking Football Group.

<b>Summary:</b>	Lancaster Street Pastors would like funding to contribute to the ongoing costs of the voluntary group. Street Pastors assist vulnerable people during the night time economy, for example, supplying water to those highly intoxicated.		
<b>Recommendation:</b>	1. That this application is supported by the Commissioner 2. That a grant of £2,500 is provided to Lancaster Street Pastors.

<b>AREA:</b>	Preston	<b>PRIORITY:</b>	Tackle Crime & ASB.
<b>AMOUNT REQUESTED:</b>	£2,000	<b>Match Funds:</b>	Organisations own resources.
<b>Project Name &amp; Cost</b>	North End Junior Football Club £2,000		
<b>Summary:</b>	Walton North End FC run diversionary outdoor activities, two days a week to young people aged 8-16 years with the aim to reduce anti-social behaviour. Walton North End FC would like funding to contribute towards the ongoing costs of the project.		
<b>Recommendation:</b>	1. That this application is supported by the Commissioner 2. That a grant of £2,000 is provided to Walton North End FC.

<b>AREA:</b>	Blackburn	<b>PRIORITY:</b>	Tackle Crime & ASB
<b>AMOUNT REQUESTED:</b>	£727	<b>Match Funds:</b>	None.
<b>Project Name &amp; Cost</b>	Piggy Park Padlocked £727		
<b>Summary:</b>	The Piggy Park Association has experienced numerous ASB incidents and therefore wish to purchase and install a metal shed to store their equipment. The site is regularly used for activities with children and young people from various clubs and schools.		
<b>Recommendation:</b>	1. That this application is supported by the Commissioner. 2. That a grant of £727 is provided to the Piggy Park Community Garden Association.

<b>Project Name &amp; Cost</b>	Human Trafficking Outreach Project £1,400		
<b>Details:</b>	Hope for Justice wish to produce multilingual flyers detailing general trafficking indicators and the process to report such crimes to raise awareness of human trafficking. Hope for Justice would also run outreach & awareness raising events.		
<b>Recommendation:</b>	1. That this application is <b>NOT</b> supported by the Commissioner. 2. That it is noted that Hope for Justice are not a local community organisation and have more than £10k in unrestricted reserves.		

<b>B. NAME:</b>	Show Racism the Red Card

<b>Project Name &amp; Cost</b>	The Red Card Hate Crime Project £2,400		
<b>Details:</b>	Show Racism the Red Card wish to run two full day educational events at two Lancashire Football Clubs to young people to discuss racism and hate crime through workshops, guest speakers and a film.		
<b>Recommendation:</b>	1. That this application is <b>NOT</b> supported by the Commissioner. 2. That it is noted that Show Racism the Red Card have more than £10k in unrestricted reserves and are not a local community group.

<b>AREA:</b>	Hyndburn	<b>PRIORITY:</b>	Tackle Crime & ASB.
<b>AMOUNT REQUESTED:</b>	£1,550	<b>Match Funds:</b>	Organisations own resources.

<b>Details:</b>	Community Solutions North West has been targeted to vandalism and criminal damage and therefore wish to purchase and install lighting to their building which is used to support and work with vulnerable people.

That it is noted that Community Solutions North West are already receiving funding from one of the Commissioner's other funding streams and are therefore not eligible for CAF Funding.</li> <li>3.
