TITLE: VICTIMS FUNDING 2015/16

Executive Summary

- 1. The Commissioner has received funding of £1,636,212 from the Ministry of Justice for victims services including just under £35K identified by the MoJ for Sexual Violence and Domestic Violence services
- 2. Victim services have already been commissioned from Victim Support, Victim Voice and Trust House/Birchall Trust. Restorative Justice services, and other projects and initiatives have also been funded to a total value of £968,628.00.
- 3. Domestic Abuse is one of the Commissioner's priorities and this decision is in line with providing services that deliver outcomes for this priority.
- 4. This Decision seeks to confirm the allocation of £30,174 from the Victims Grant Funding for the provision of support workers for the Lancashire County Council area MASH for the period October 2015 – 31 March 2016, and a commitment to provide continuation funding for the period April 2016 – March 2017 from future MoJ Victims Grant Funding. Details of the proposals are attached in Appendix B.
- 5. If this Decision is confirmed, there will be a balance of £450,000 remaining in the Victims Grant Fund for allocation against future victim support services.

Recommendation:

The Commissioner is recommended to approve the proposed use of the Victims Grant Fund as outlined in Appendix B and to note the implications in respect of funding that could be available for future victim support services.
