Executive Summary

- The Commissioner's revenue budget for 2020-2021 includes an allocation for Reducing Reoffending Funding.
- The Commissioner launched a grant opportunity in July 2020 for organisations who provide support to offenders. Organisations could apply for up to £25,000 for projects and initiatives which meet at least one of the key aims of the reducing reoffending strategy as well as the Police and Crime Commissioners priorities.
- The Reducing Reoffending Fund closed on Monday 3rd August 2020 with 10 organisations submitting applications for funding.
- This Decision seeks to confirm the allocation of £89,350.00 from the Reducing Reoffending Fund to the four projects and initiatives outlined in Appendix A.

The Commissioner is recommended to approve £89,350.00 from the Reducing Reoffending Fund for the four projects outlined in Appendix A.
